

Rules and regulations of the text message service autism-test.org.uk

§1

The service is provided by autism-test.org.uk

§2

Support services related to Premium Text Messages are provided by Paysera.

§3

The service consists in making a single-use code available. Such code is necessary to obtain access ASD probability state analysis. After sending a text message saying “*PIP AUTISM*” or „*PIP C3GBP*” to “*Premium Number*”, the User received a text message with a code.

§4

The premium number	SMS price incl. VAT	SMS price excl. VAT

The service is available for the EE, Three, O2, Vodafone, Sure, Jersey Telecom, Manx Telecom network and all MVNO virtual networks.

§5

The single-use code is granted only after sending a text message with exact command and Premium number in a correct manner. The User will receive a message about an incorrectly sent command if the text message is incorrect. According to the rules, GSM operators collect a charge for each text message send at the time it was sent, even if this was an incorrect text message. The organiser is not obliged to reimburse the costs related to the text message or resending a code, if the User has sent as incorrect contents.

§6

In order to limit telecommunications frauds, some restrictions on the number of text messages sent from one MSISDN number within one day have been introduced to the website.

§7

The User has the right to submit a complaint arising from Website’s operation, failure to receive a text message with a code despite sending a correct text message within 7 days from the day on which the event resulting in the complaint occurred by sending an e-mail to the following address: help@autism-test.org.uk In case of any doubts, the User may seek assistance at: (+48) 532 879 486.
